Every effort has been made to identify those who attended the reunions, but not everyone's identity was clear.

Burnett Reunion. 1879

During a visit of a number of relatives at the home of John Cole in 1879 the question of a reunion of the Descendants of J^m Burnett was discussed and as a result a call for such a reunion was issued to be held at the residence of Jas. M. Burnett in Hubbard, Ohio On 1879.

In pursuance of such a call the relatives and friends to the number of over one hundred met and spent a most enjoyable day.

Old ties were strengthened and many relatives who had never before met there clasped hands, and loving and enduring friendships were formed which we trust will never be broken, except as one by one we answer to the call of the Master to come to the great and final reunion. At the business meeting Jas. M. Burnett was called to preside and A. C. Burnett made Secretary. It was decided to make the reunion an annual meeting and that the next meeting be held at the home of Joseph Burnett of Hartford on the third Wednesday in August 1880. Jas. D. Burnett was elected President for the ensuing year and A. C. Burnett secretary.

Speeches were made by Silas and Joseph Burnett and a number of others, and a collection taken to defray expenses.

For the ensuing year, John Cole was elected president, C. C. Jones, Treasurer and A. C. Burnett, secretary, and it was decided to hold the next meeting with J. D. Burnett of Oradenville, O.

— 1883 —

The reunion for this year was held at the regular time at the residence of J. D. Burnett, Orangeville, O. We were pleasantly surprised as we arrived at the place of meeting in seeing a long table with a tent covering it, full length, this had been prepared by our worthy host. A collection was taken to pay for the cloth purchased but J. D. refused to accept anything for the labor or lumber and the family accepted it as a gift from him.

As long as it shall last it will be a pleasant reminder of his love and generosity. There was a very full attendance and a very pleasant meeting was held. At the business meeting E. W. Brockway was elected President, A. C. Burnett Secretary + C. C. Jones Treas. and on invitation of J. A. Shatto it was voted to hold the next meeting at his home.

On December 8th of this year it will have been one hundred and thirty years since the founder of our family, William Burnett was born. He was probably of German ancestry but was born an Englishman, for at that time, Dec. 8th 1771, America was a British Colony. Probably even then some one had dreamed of American Independence, but there had been no public agitation of the question. His birth ante-dated by three years the famous Boston Tea Party and he was five and a half years old when Independence was declared and twelve years old before it was finally attained. So that he must have had some personal knowledge of this stirring event. It is to be regretted that he took no pains to make a record of his early life. Courtney and of this union eight children were born: Cynthia, Alcinda, Elizabeth, Albert, Maria, Olive, William and Melissa. These all survive except Elizabeth and William who died in 1875 shortly after the death of Grandfather. The record is, --

Grandfather's grave is decorated annually by the G. A. R. of Brookfield.

Peter was married _____ to Euseba Axtell and five children were born to them. One, Samuel, was killed while fighting for the Union in the War of the Rebellion, being the only one of the family who was killed in that War, although more than a dozen of the grandsons were in the service. Abijah H. Spence, Mary Jane, and Washington survive. The record is:

Nine years elapsed after the birth of Peter, before there was another recorded birth, though doubtless, some of the nine whom grandfather records as having died without a name were born in the interval. He was born August 8, 1821, and his wife, whose maiden name was Elenor Snyder, also survives. They were the parents of eight children. October 6, 1832, we have our last recorded birth. It was a daughter and they named her Marietta. She was married _____ to Gideon Burnett and died _____. Five children were born to them: Enos, Corrin, Sadie, John, and Cora, all of whom still live.

Great grandchildren – Two – Two surviving

In this the youngest branch of the family all children still live making a total of sixteen.

Our grandfather was a man of both industrious and frugal habits. Shortly after his arrival in Hubbard he built a sawmill and from this and a large farm he not only kept a large family but accumulated quite a property so that in his day he was accounted wealthy. Later in his life when his mind began to fail, he lost much of this through the trickery of others. In 1861 one or two of the older children quit claimed all interest in the remainder of the property to the youngest daughter, Marietta, for which she agreed to care for both during life, see that they were properly buried and erect tombstones at their graves. I think she kept the agreement in all respects. About April 1, 1863, grandmother died. The loss of her so preyed upon grandfather that on the twelfth of the same month he died. He did not leave his children a legacy of wealth, but he did leave them a legacy of much greater worth: that of strong, robust bodies and true and honest hearts. May it continue to run through the

veins of the future generations so that in a hundred years from now, that not one of his descendants has brought lasting disgrace upon the family.
