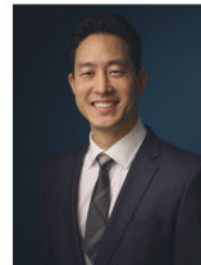

ABOUT THE CANADIAN NATIONAL KENDO CHAMPIONSHIPS

This year is the first time the Canadian Kendo Federation (CKF) will be hosting a national tournament for both adults and children in a two-day event: the **21st Canadian National Kendo Championships and 2nd Annual Canadian Junior National Kendo Championships**.

The 21st Nationals is the first national tournament held after the cancellation of 20th Nationals due to the COVID-19 pandemic, which was planned to be held in 2020. The Canadian National Kendo Championships (CNKC) is held every three years and it is a key event in the selection of the Men's and Women's Canadian National Teams (Team Canada) which will compete in the World Kendo Championships. WKC has been held every three years hosted by the International Kendo Federation (FIK) since 1970. The Canadian Kendo Federation (CKF) was founded in 1970, and Canada has participated in every WKC.

The 2nd Annual Junior Nationals is a tournament that is held annually for all Canadian children under the age of 19. CKF held the first inaugural tournament in Calgary, Alberta in 2022 with great success. By hosting a national tournament every year for juniors, CKF aims to foster the next generation of Kendo players to build and strengthen the Canadian Kendo community.

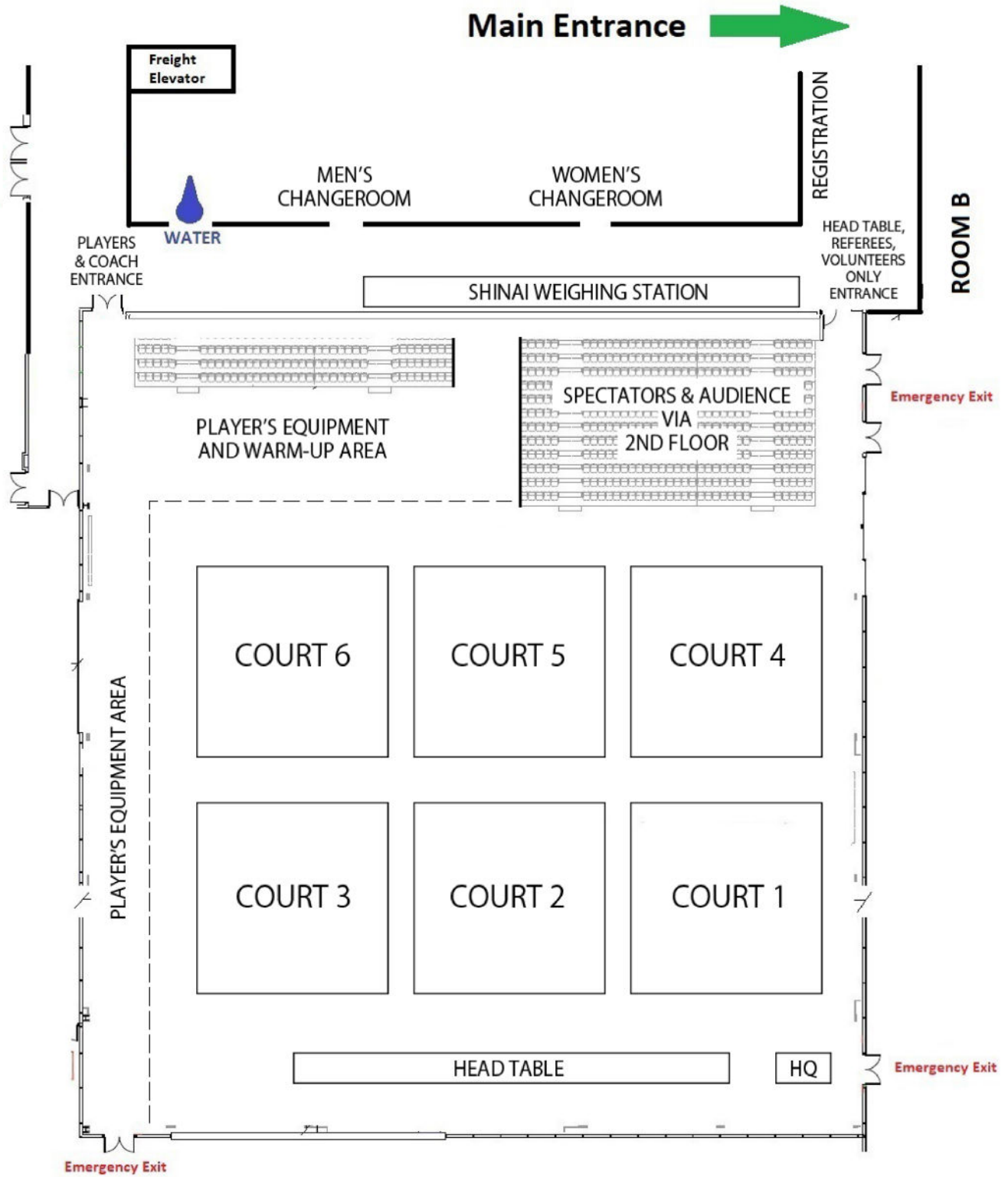

VENUE INFORMATION

Registration table will be in the lobby from 7:30 AM for both Day 1 (Saturday, August 12) & Day 2 (Sunday, August 13)

Competitors and coaches will enter through the west gym entrance. All competitors and coaches shall either remain in the designated warm up areas if he/she is still competing or watch matches from the spectator area if he/she is no longer competing.

Only players, their coaches and the on-deck competitors / teams for the next two matches will be allowed into the court area.

All non-competing audience watching the matches should be in the spectator area entered via the second floor.

Multipurpose rooms in the second floor will be available for lunch during the scheduled lunch times.

Day 1 - Multipurpose Rooms 1+2, 3+4 will be available from 11am - 2pm.

Day 2 - Multipurpose Rooms 3+4 will be available from 12am - 2pm.

No food and drinks except for water is allowed into the gym.



KENDO MATCH INFORMATION & BASICS

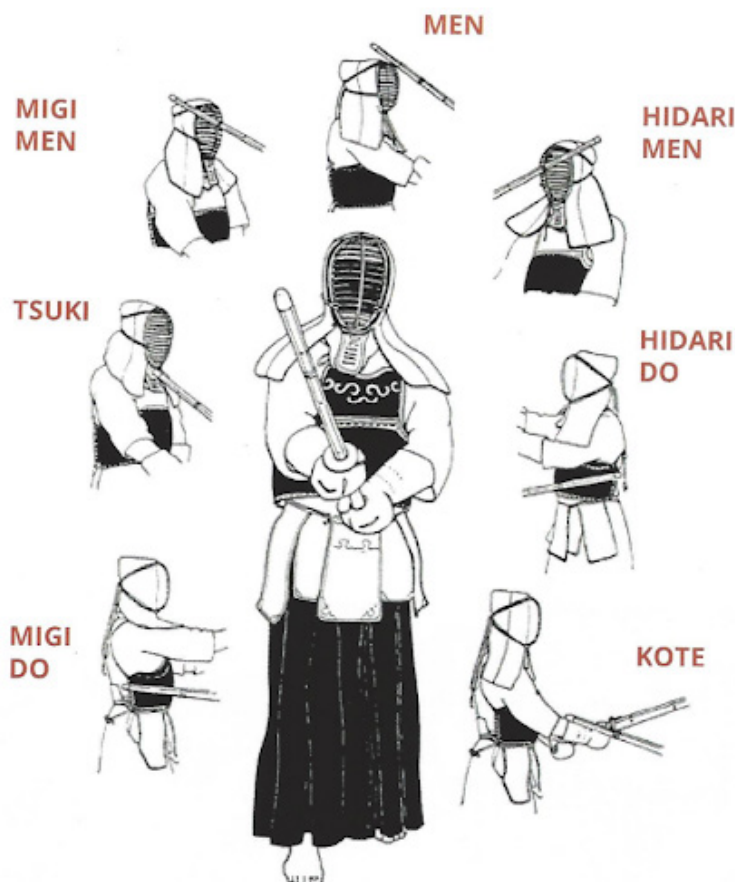
The Basics of a Kendo Competition

Individual matches are over in a three to five minute time period, which is announced before the competition, and the winner is the first to score two out of three points, IPPON.

In the individual's single-elimination tournament competition, in case of a tie, the match will be extended, "encho-sen" (sudden death) and first point wins.

In cases of round robin or team matches, matches can end in a tie.

In team competitions the winners are determined by the total number of match wins, and if both teams have equal amounts of wins, the total number of points wins the match. In the case where teams are still tied, an additional match "daihyosen" where each team selects one representative will be played to determine the winning team.



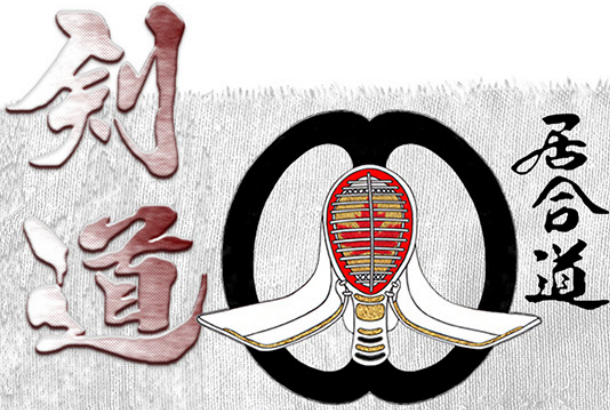
Point Scores

To score a point, the blow must be delivered with clarity and precision, using the outer third of the shinai. There are four specific target areas in Kendo, each worth one point in a match. They are strikes to the head (MEN), the body (DO), the wrist (KOTE), and a thrust to the throat (TSUKI).

Players can be penalized for illegal actions, for example, by stepping out of bounds. When a player is penalized, referees will give a warning "hansoku" to the offending player. If a player receives two hansokus, the opponent will receive an Ippon.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The tournament rules will follow “The Regulations of Kendo Shiai and Shinpan (September 2nd, 2017 – “The Regulations” and subsequent corrections”, published by International Kendo Federation (FIK). In addition, Shinpan will apply the Provisional Match and Referee Rules as developed by All Japan Kendo Federation (ZNKR).

Round Robin

- Each group will consist of 3 or 4 players.
- Each player will play against each other in the same group.
- Each match will be “sanbon-shobu” (first to score 2 ippons), 3 minutes, no overtime
- If the match is tied after time expires, the result of the match is a tie.
- After all matches in the group are played, points for each player will be calculated as follows:
 - Wins – 2 points each
 - Ties – 1 point each
 - Losses – 0 point each
- Winner of the group will be determined in the following order:
 1. Player with the most Points (Wins, Ties, Losses)
 2. Player with the most Wins
 3. Player with the most Ippons
 4. If two players are tied after the above, an additional match will be played. The match will be “ippon-shobu” (first to score ippon) with unlimited time.
 5. If more than two players are tied after the above, then another round of matches will be played by the players that are tied. Each match will be “ippon-shobu” (first to score ippon). After all matches are done, then all the tie-breakers rules above will be applied until a winner is determined.
- For some divisions, the runner-up in the group will win 3rd place overall in the division. The same rules as above will be used to determine the runner-up of the group.

U11 Boys and Girls Individuals and U19 Girls Individuals

- Players in each group will compete in the round robin format as outlined above.
- The first and second place players will come out of each Group.
- Winner of Group A will stay on the left side of the tournament tree.
- Winner of Group B will stay on the left side of the tournament tree.
- The 2nd place player from Group A will compete against the winner of Group B.
- The 2nd place player from Group B will compete against the winner of Group A.

Tournament Stage

- Single elimination tournament.
- Each match will be “sanbon-shobu” (first to score 2 ippons), 4 or 5 minutes (depending on the division, see above), unlimited sudden-death overtime.

Senior Youth Girls Team Round Robin

- All 3 teams will play each other in round robin format as outlined above.

Tournament Stage

- Single elimination tournament
- Each team match will consist 3 or 5 individual matches (depending on division, see above)
- Each team must submit their team lineup prior to the end of the match before their next team match.
- Each individual match will be, "sanbon-shobu" (first to score 2 Ippons), 3-5 minutes (depending on the division, see above), no overtime
- If the match is tied after time expires, the result of the match is a tie.
- The winning team will be determined by the following:
 1. Team with most Wins
 2. Team with most Ippons
 3. If teams are tied after the above, then each team will select 1 representative to play an additional 1 point match with unlimited time to determine the winner.
