BOYNTON BEACH, FLA. and SHERMAN MILLS - Clifton Weston Rand, 94, died at Bethesda Hospital in Boynton Beach, Fla., Jan. 17, 1999, after a brief illness. He was born March 31, 1904, on Golden Ridge, Sherman Mills, the son of Edward W. and Jennie (Blodgett) Rand.

He was a graduate of Sherman High School, Class of 1922, earned a bachelor's degree in business administration from Boston University in 1927, and a master's degree from Harvard University in 1929. He was predeceased by his first wife, Roselyn Orrin Rand and a sister, Etta Rand Grant.

Elwin Everett Rand, 76, died Sunday at Seaside Nursing Home after battling cancer.

Born in Amherst, Mass., a son of Arden W. and Minnie Flanders Rand, he graduated from New Gloucester High School in 1940 and Dexter Trade School.

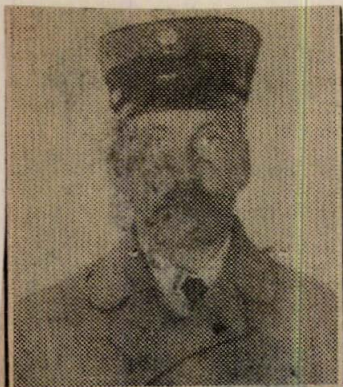

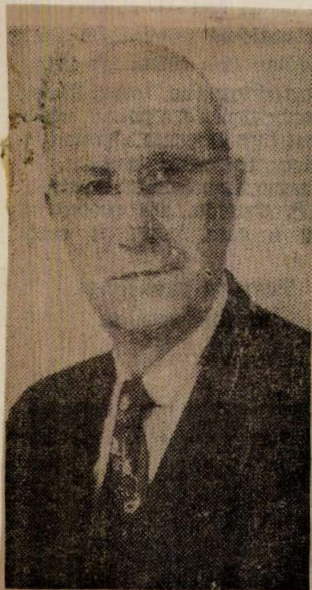

Clifford S.
