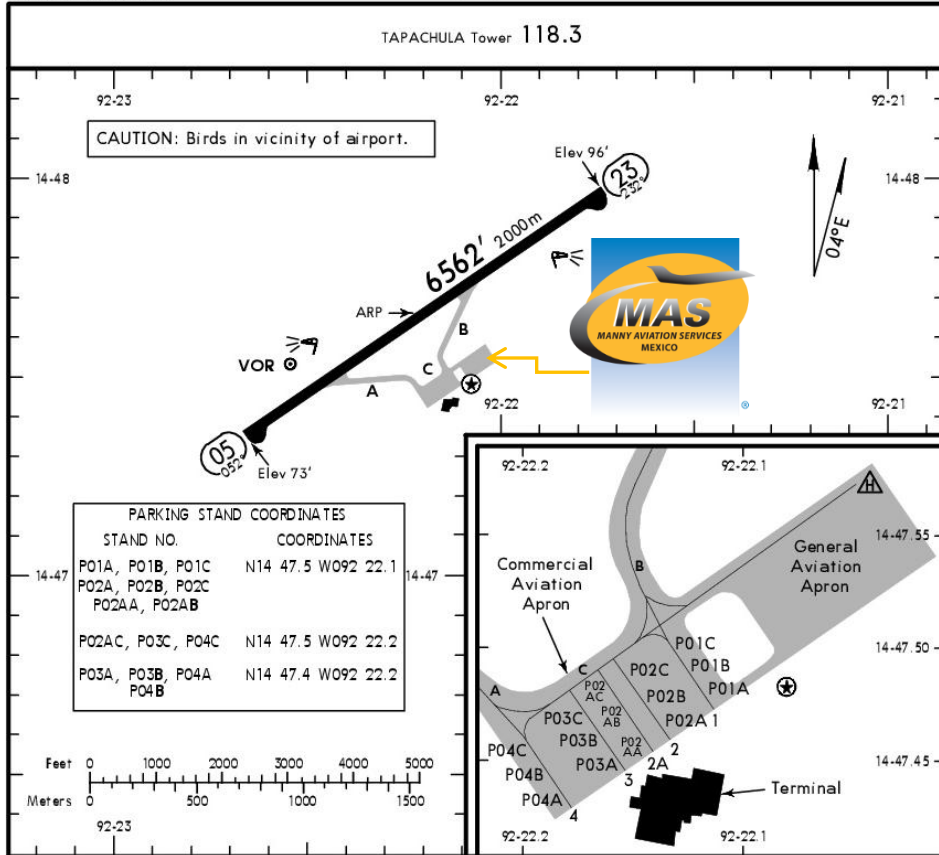

MMTP/TAP TAPACHULA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Arrival

1. Upon arrival aircraft must follow ATC instructions for taxiing to the general aviation or commercial platforms; this will depend on aircraft wing span.
2. Crew and passengers passports will be asked by one of our staff representatives.
3. The first approach from the authorities will be held by the Army, after their approval (this can take up to 25 minutes) customs and immigration will approach as well, in the meantime our staff will have to unload all the luggage and place it under the wing so authorities may use a K9 unit to check it if there is any kind of drugs or explosives, then the passengers will have to disembark and walk to the general aviation terminal to have their passports checked, while the passengers walk through the customs processes, our staff will be there at all times.
4. All paperwork must be shown in original.
5. When all processes are finished, the passengers and crew may return to the aircraft if they plan to go inside Mexico. (If MMTP is their final destination, then they have to proceed outside of the building to take their transportation).
6. The whole process takes around 60 to 95 minutes.

Salida

1. Our staff representatives will ask for the crew and passengers passports as well as their luggage.
2. Passports and luggage will be taken to customs & immigration clearance; they will randomly select which luggage will be inspected. Once this is finished they may get onboard.
3. The whole process will take around between 30 to 45 minutes.
