## President's Report

The Western Region Football League (WRFL) has taken many significant steps in 2009 to develop its competition and role as a community leader in Melbourne's Western Region. Over 7,200 people played the game of Australian Rules Football in our League this year and another 20,000 directly participated each week. At a time when greater demands are being made on time and resources and the level of community engagement appears to be reducing, the WRFL continues to stand as an example of people's willingness to make a commitment to their families, their Club and Association and the wider community.

### Completion of the 2007-2009 WRFL Strategic Plan

Three years ago and in consultation with the WRFL Clubs, the WRFL Board and Administration set out to create a Strategic Plan which would form the foundation of the WRFL's future direction, objectives and community participation. The 2007-2009 WRFL Strategic Plan was formulated and has since guided the WRFL's activities and achieved many significant results, including:

- Sustained annual growth in player registrations across the competition
- Cultural change through the decoupling of the WRFL from alcohol sponsorship and the adoption of the National Alcohol Code of Conduct
- A 'light alcohol' only 2009 Finals Series conducted without incident
- Establishment of the Women's Football Foundation with Patron Deputy Prime Minister Julia Gillard MP
- Strong financial management and solid financial annual returns
- Organisational restructure of the Board and the Administration for improved management and support to Clubs and players
- Coaching and skills development initiatives to support a strong competition
- A 40% reduction in reportable incidents since 2007

- Introduction of AFL Victoria recommended Umpire structures and development framework
- Development of the Interleague Program with the inclusion of the Western Jets, Williamstown Football Club and the Werribee Football Club
- 98% compliance with the AFL Victoria Quality League Framework

With this Strategic Plan now coming to an end and a new direction soon to be determined, it is appropriate to acknowledge these advances and achievements that the WRFL has enjoyed over this period.

### Alcohol strategy and behaviour

At the end of Season 2008, the WRFL Board convened a forum that was attended by representatives from across the WRFL, along with members of the Victoria Police. The forum was held in response to specific incidents during the Season 2008 that were related to alcohol and behaviour. The result was the formulation of many agreed initiatives that would be implemented during the 2009 Season to make the WRFL a more family friendly environment where players and the community could enjoy our game. This response would be the WRFL's 'line in the sand' in respect to the organisation's approach towards alcohol management and the lifting of behavioural standards.

A risk management strategy was also developed as part of this process with a number of key components. In 2009, these included the decoupling of the WRFL from its alcohol sponsorship arrangements and finding new ways to raise corporate support. The National Alcohol Code of Conduct was adopted and WRFL Clubs made the management of acceptable behavioural standards amongst their players and supports at games and social events a priority. Importantly, the 2009 Finals Series was run as a 'light alcohol' only event with a terrific crowd response and the games were conducted without incident.

The WRFL has made significant cultural changes in 2009 through its preparedness to tackle these issues, and has demonstrated that Football does not need alcohol to survive and thrive.

### Competition development – Senior and Junior

There have been many big improvers in 2009 both on and off the field amongst the WRFL's Clubs, and the race to make the Finals Series in both the Junior and Senior competitions, along with a strongly contested Finals Series itself, was testament to the work and dedication of all our Clubs this season.

After another fiercely contested Grand Final against the Port Colts Football Club which was appearing in its sixth straight Grand Final, the Spotswood Football Club became Division 1 Premiers for the third consecutive year. In the Division 1 Reserves competition, the Albion Football Club took out the premiership over the Hoppers Crossing Football Club in a terrific finish to the Season. In the Division 2 competition, we congratulate the Deer Park Football Club on its Division 2 Premiership against the Parkside Football Club which had earlier displayed a Season of dominant Football. The Parkside Football Club also showed the depth of its talent this year by winning the Division 2 Reserves Premiership.

The WRFL's Under 18 competition continues to develop from strength to strength and it is very rewarding to see our former Junior players developing at this level of the competition. We congratulate the Werribee Juniors Football Club for its Under 18A Premiership and the Albion Football Club for winning the Under 18B competition.

The co-ordination and supervision of the Junior competition is one of the most important functions which is undertaken by the WRFL. In 2009, the WRFL further strengthened its grading process and adopted AFL Victoria's preferred operating model. The result was a greater evenness of the competition across each grade and our Junior players were able to excel and enjoy their Football in this environment. The WRFL has also been committed to the re-introduction of the U13 competition in 2009 and this opportunity provided many young people with the chance to improve their skills at this level.

### Support across the Community

I wish to thank the WRFL's major sponsor, McKnights Retrovision in Hoppers Crossing, for their outstanding support in 2009. The company's

commitment to the WRFL over the past two years has enabled us to further professionalise the competition by providing much needed support and resources. I also wish to thank all of our WRFL sponsors for their loyalty and commitment, without which, we could not provide access to Football for so many people.

The WRFL Judiciary has again performed with independence and integrity under the guidance of Dale Sayner (Tribunal) and John Doherty (Appeal Board). I thank each of these Chairmen and their Judicial Members for volunteering their time in these roles this year. I also wish to acknowledge the additional and critical work which Dale Sayner has continued to undertake in running training and education programs for Judicial Members, Player Advocates and Umpire Advocates.

On behalf of all WRFL stakeholders, I also wish to thank our Umpires for their contribution to the competition in 2009. The knowledge, skills and leadership which were displayed by Umpire Managers Terry Gunn, Brett Carter and Bob Atkin, along with the Umpiring Department throughout the Season, played a key role in the further professionalisation of Umpiring in the WRFL. While the decision by some umpires to withhold their services during the Season was disappointing, what was absolutely clear was the commitment by the WRFL to ensure that our Umpiring framework and processes were modernised and gave people the best possible opportunities to excel.

We also acknowledge the invaluable work of Sam Fenech, President of the WRFL Trainers Association and all the Trainers for the support and expertise that they have brought to the field each week in 2009.



The WRFL has also enjoyed extensive media coverage this year through the print, internet and radio arms of its Media division. Led by Media Manager Kevin Hillier, the stories of the WRFL have been covered with enthusiasm and passion by people who understand our game and competition and we thank them for their efforts. The support of the Star Newspaper Group has also continued to ensure that we are able to capture and communicate events which represent the heart and soul of our League.

#### **Women in Football**

The WRFL continues to lead the way by promoting and actively supporting the role of women and girls in Australian Rules Football. The Women's Football Foundation has had another very successful season and through the support of its Patron, the Deputy Prime Minister Julia Gillard MP, has further raised its profile and importance within the community.

The WRFL was also very pleased to have directly supported the Victorian Women's Football League in 2009 by the provision of administration and operational support through the dual appointment of Stacey Goad, Business Manager. Participation levels in the VWFL are growing every year, and the WRFL was proud to play a role in this development through the utilisation of its Football expertise by supporting the management of the competition.

#### **WRFL Board and Administration**

The commitment shown by the WRFL Administration in 2009 to providing not only the best possible competition, but also additional support services to its participants, has been outstanding. On behalf of the Board and everyone at the WRFL, I wish to acknowledge and thank our dedicated team of John Batty, Chief Executive Officer, David Newton, General Manager – Football Operations, Ben McManus, Football Operations and Club Development Officer and Stacey Goad, Business Manager.

We are very fortunate that people with such integrity and commitment to the game have chosen to work for the WRFL. Their collective ability to work so effectively with our sponsors, the AFL, AFL Victoria, State Government, Councils and other football bodies has meant that the WRFL continues to advance in all these areas. The healthy financial position of the WRFL and strong fiscal accountability which has been applied by the WRFL's Administrators and Board in reaching this

result will have long term benefits for the WRFL.

The WRFL Board has also demonstrated a strong and passionate commitment to the WRFL in 2009. With 33 Clubs and many more stakeholders, the Board's ability to consistently make decisions that are fair, reasonable and in the best interests of the WRFL as a whole is to be commended.



The WRFL's Vice-President Stephen Myall, has given countless hours to the WRFL over many years and in the past two seasons in particular, to ensure that the organisation is conducted professionally and with integrity. ## Football Operations Report

The Western Region Football League has again been able to provide the Western Region community with a terrific opportunity to be involved in our proud league.

At the end of the 2008 season the operations department underwent reviews on some key areas within the league including the WRFL finals series.

A review of the WRFL Junior grading process was conducted which is an integral part to the success of our junior competitions. The review which coincided with AFL Victoria's grading review focused on the need to promote measures that will maximize the enjoyment, development, recruitment and retention of our young junior participants. The

2009 season in comparison to previous years has provided more competitive matches across the grades as a result.

This year we also implemented and introduced the WRFL Risk Management framework. The framework highlighted the responsibility of all involved in the WRFL to ensure a safe and friendly environment at our football matches. The framework provided an incident log to assist the league and clubs in dealing with issues that may arise throughout our matches. Further to this the WRFL introduced a low alcohol policy at all of our Senior Finals matches which contributed to the exceptional behavior experienced across all aspects of our series.

There were many highlights throughout the 2009 home and away season. The WRFL dedicated a round of matches to assist the VCFL Victorian Bushfire Appeal in which the clubs contributed a substantial amount to the appeal. The Under 13 competition was reintroduced as part of the grading review. We hope that more clubs will field an under 13 team in 2010 to allow for more grades across the competition. The Interleague program again provided an opportunity for over 200 of our elite junior players to participate in matches against other metropolitan football leagues.

Once again some of our junior players went on to excel at a higher level. Callan Ward (Spotswood)

was nominated for the NAB Rising Star Award and Jayden Post (Altona Juniors) showed that he will be a key position player for the Richmond FC for years to come.

The Junior Presentation Night is always a night to remember for many of our junior players and it was reassuring to have Liam Picken (Western Bulldogs) along to share his experiences about his football career to date. The main point of his talk was about enjoyment of the game and his will to succeed.

The Junior Finals Series was again a showcase of our junior program with over 80% of junior clubs represented during the series. The finals series culminated with one of the best displays of skill, sportsmanship and teamwork with the Under 16 A Grand Final between Spotswood and Williamstown Juniors. The huge crowd, as experienced throughout the whole series was treated to a match to remember for a very long time.

Like previous years the Senior Finals series boasted great crowds and entertaining matches. The Division One finals were held over three venues being Crofts Reserve, Altona & Chirnside Park.

For the third year running both Port Melbourne Colts and Spotswood made it to the last weekend in the WRFL Finals Series. Spotswood was able to emulate the feat of Braybrook in 1973-1975 who were the last of three clubs to achieve the 'Three Peat' and win their fourteenth Division 1 Premiership by 18 points. Port Melbourne Colts played in their sixth consecutive Grand Final which is a great achievement in itself.

In the Reserves match Hoppers Crossing contested their third Reserves Grand Final in four years but it was Albion who claimed the flag winning their first open age premierships since 1994 by 24 points.

The Werribee Juniors played off in their fifth consecutive under 18 A Grand Final and were successful in winning back to back premierships after beating Hoppers Crossing by 39 points. As always the Under 18 A Grand Final is an early highlight of the day showcasing a high level of skill and class.

The Division Two season was hotly contested to the final round with Deer Park, Yarraville Seddon & Laverton Magpies all vying for the last two spots in the finals at the last round. In the end it was Yarraville Seddon that missed the finals by no more than 1.11%. It was Deer Park who came from fourth to contest the Grand Final with the undefeated Parkside. In what was an outstanding Grand Final, Deer Park ran out eventual winners after an outstanding second half of football outclassing Parkside by 21 points.

Parkside defeated North Footscray by 46 points in the Division Two reserves Grand Final while Albion reined premiers over Werribee Juniors in the Under 18 B's running out 72 point victors.

I would personally like to thank the clubs and their volunteers who hosted finals matches and all those individuals who assisted in making the finals a success.

The WRFL relies heavily on those volunteers who assist with the different aspects of football operations as without them the competition wouldn't be where it is today.

## Development Report

What a year to look back on in the Western Region Football League for the 2009 year.

Club Development is improving the professionalism of the League as a whole and all clubs should be commended for the hard work in what has been another long year. The Wilson Security Club of the Year award was a terrific contest between three clubs who continually strive hard to improve their off field stature in North Footscray, Sunshine Heights and Coburg Districts. Congratulations to Sunshine Heights who took out the award for 2009. To their credit all three clubs also achieved AFL Victoria's Quality Club silver level status. Let's hope every WRFL club can achieve Bronze level in 2010.

Together with the WRFL Executive the League continues to take a strong standpoint against alcohol

abuse. In working with a variety of stakeholders, including Western Melbourne Headspace, we hope to gradually change and improve the culture of the League for the better. The WRFL and clubs also supported the AFL Kids First program. This is a program which assists football clubs and leagues to guide parents so that both they and their children obtain the maximum benefit and enjoyment from their participation in junior programs and matches. It is important to ensure that all parents within the WRFL recognise that they play an important role in supporting their child's football activities, but should act in a constructive and encouraging manner. Clubs should be focussing on developing their relationships with their local Auskick clinic to act as a feeder.

It has been excellent to see the clubs develop their

relationships with Council. A strong club will seek assistance when required and there is no better resource to clubs than their local council.

This year saw 8 teams represent the WRFL against other Leagues with our teams showcasing the best skills and talent that the WRFL has to offer.

We had another successful day in the U12s and U13s round robin day. Werribee Centrals hosted our day extremely efficiently and Point Cook assisted in managing a training venue. Special mention to WRFL Executive Member Janine Mizzi. Once again her assistance with the U12 and U13 sides was appreciated. Four of our teams participated in the U14 and U15 AFL Victoria Metropolitan Championships. The Western Jets had a strong involvement in the development of all of our

Championships sides. Thanks to the Hobson's Bay Council we were permitted to train at the Western Jets training ground at Crofts Reserve, a fantastic surface. All players will be presented with further opportunities for development, be it through the Western Jets and Calder Cannons or through WRFL Interleague sides in years to come. Thanks to Williamstown FC for their continued support of the Junior Interleague Program. Our U16 and U18 program was revamped in 2009 with the assistance of the Werribee Tigers. Robbie Castello, Vice Captain of the Werribee Tigers, organised a fantastic training program for all these boys that will hopefully provide them with some exciting football opportunities in the future.

Thanks to the Western Jets team for their assistance with this program in 2009. The links developed with the WRFL and the Western Jets continue to be a mutually beneficial partnership.

Thank you to all coaches, team managers, runners, trainers, water persons, umpires and assistant coaches for offering their time and services throughout the program and to the parents who ferried all the players to and from training and games. It is your passion for junior development that enables this program to occur. Thanks to our Umpiring Department, Umpires Association and the Trainers Association for their assistance in the

program. Your cooperation ensures these important development steps for our juniors go ahead.

The 2009 Junior Fun Day was once again hosted by Spotswood, Port Melbourne Colts and North Footscray. It is a superb way to finish the season for the U9 and U10 teams from all around the League and a great social occasion. Thank you to the host clubs for their time and effort in preparing their venues to ensure it is a safe and fun environment to benefit from. All players showed great enthusiasm throughout the season and this will hopefully encourage them to have a long association with the WRFL.

This year we had twenty eight of our thirty one clubs field teams in the underage competition. The was a strong junior presence in the League from Hoppers Crossing, Williamstown Juniors, Werribee Juniors, Point Cook and St Bernard's. Despite clubs having to continually adapt to battle the drought conditions it is fantastic to see that they and the League still provide the biggest health competition in Western Melbourne. A strong majority of our clubs who competed in juniors went on to be represented in



the finals and from the fifteen junior premierships contested there were ten different clubs who came away with a premiership indicating the evenness of the junior competition. The continual development of the WRFL Grading policy will only improve the closeness of our junior competitions in years to come.

It was another successful finals series from an operations view point and we saw many closely fought games with impressive displays of skills and spirit despite the inclement weather. # Umpires Report

---

Season 2009 wasn't without its challenges for the umpiring department, but in the face of adversity we witnessed overwhelming support from the Umpires Association, the WRFL and a collection of independent and club officials prepared to pitch in to assist in developing umpiring where ever they could.

We would like to pass on our thanks and gratitude to those individuals appointed mid season to assist with observation, coaching and selection of finals umpires (field, goals and boundary); Umpires Association President and Secretary elect, members of the umpires Forum and all running umpires for their assistance and positive impact they had on the group from round 12 onwards.

## Resources

- Umpiring numbers were good this season as a result of the introduction of the Umpiring Academy at McKillop Colleague Hoppers Crossing. The Academy introduced 30 new umpires in total, most entering their first season on the boundary with a few others spread across goals and field. Existing umpire numbers were fairly constant with little change.

On behalf of the Umpiring Department we would like to thank Mark and Matt Westgarth for driving this very important program in its debutant year and look forward to the Umpiring Academy being the major provider of all new your umpires in the years to come.

**Goals** – Headed up by Sebastian Garrow our goal umpires group this season was strongly supported by our senior more experienced umpires.

**Boundary** – It was a fantastic year for our boundary umpires group strongly assisted by the influx of new umpires from the McKillop Umpires Academy, we had the enviable situation of most, if not all games being covered by official boundary umpires. That is not to say we have enough umpires, we could always do with more youngsters wanting to earn some spending money on a Saturday afternoon.

The introduction of 4 boundary umpires into the Division 1 senior Grand Final was a great decision making for outstanding coverage of the ground and likelihood of error almost completely eliminated. This did well for our team morale with many umpires still in contention throughout finals series.

**Field** – While still short of developing enough young umpires ready to supersede our older more experienced brigade, we still had what I consider a successful season with many of our developing umpires performing at a high level. Congratulations to Adam Van Kuyk on being nominated to trial for the VFL in preparation for season

2010. We wish Adam all the very best and hope he does himself and WRFL Umpires proud.

Our responsibility for season 2010 is to drive as many developing umpires through the level 1 and 2 accreditation programs as possible to ensure their development is given the best opportunity.

**Juniors** – Phil Henderson ably assisted by Rene Van Kuyk and his team did an outstanding job of managing and coordinating all umpires assigned to Sunday Junior competition. Well done gentlemen, your effort performance this year was outstanding.

**Fitness** – Terry out did himself this year with his preparation and development of umpire fitness and well being. Not only does Terry take great pride to ensure umpires are fit enough to endure the rigors of the game but also makes sure they move and think in the most positive way around clubs and the umpires association.

A big thank you to those mentioned and all others that assisted us throughout season 2009.

## Initiatives

- **Self assessment** - Umpires self assessment form to be completed by umpire and observer / umpires coach was introduced with outstanding success. While the process requires a high level of commitment from each party to complete following the game the results were very positive.
- **Reviews** - Half year review of senior field umpires was undertaken that offered good feed back and direction for developing umpired leading into the second half of the season.
- **Finals** - The number of finals umpires was increased to include 3 field umpires for U18a, Div 2 seniors and Div 1 seniors. 4 boundary umpires were introduced into Div 1 Grand Final for the first time. These changes were well received by everyone involved and made for a very high standard throughout the finals series.
- **Consistency** - Under 18 finals were officiated by those same umpires that did so throughout the home and away season. The overwhelming feedback from both umpiring group and club officials was testament to the success of this concept.
- **Tasmania** – The ongoing success of our swap with the Launceston League was again a great success.
- **Rankings Scorecard** – The introduction of a rankings score card that incorporated all 'key performance indicators' required of the field umpires assisted in the selection of finals umpires making the process more accurate and accountable.

- **Uniforms** – The introduction of orange uniforms took shape and by seasons end most umpires had proudly purchased their new gear. All finals umpires were dressed in the orange attire. The momentum should continue in season 2010 with those remaining umpires to purchase new gear.

## Highlight - 2009 Pre Finals Presentation

Captured in the Scovell club rooms of the WRFL Umpires was a collection of fantastic home grown talent from the WRFL to the highest level of the game, brought together with a mix of our current young and old umpires that make up the WRFL umpiring group. The right ingredient for what was to be a powerful evening full of great learning's and experiences from our guests.

Umpires in attendance were: Field - Matthew James 203 AFL games, 16 finals, 3 grand finals and all Australian in 2004. Troy Pannell 50 AFL games; Goals – Peter Nastasi 106 AFL games, 8 finals and 1 grand final, Darren Mills 15 AFL games; Boundary – David Card VFL, Tim Morrison VFL, Leigh Rowbottom TAC Cup, Drew Kowalski VFL and Steven Neal VFL.

First speaker was Matthew James who at the tender age of 35 is possibly one of the most successful field umpires to have umpired the game at an elite level. You could have heard a pin drop as he shared the funny, serious and more important messages to our young group.

Second speaker was Peter Nastasi who is clearly a more intense character on a mission in his early years to do whatever it took to achieve his goals. An insightful speaker who provided very structured information and facts about his path and planning for big games, particularly relevant to our group as we move into finals.

Third and final speaker was David Card who had much more to deliver than his determination to achieve as a VFL boundary umpire. David gave us a powerful speech that captured the room with his every word.

The night was an outstanding success and should be something we do more of in the future.

In summary 2009 was a season of challenge, excitement and change that brought about many special efforts by various people throughout the game and our umpires department. We would like to officially thank everyone that assisted us in our duties through the season and hope that you too got great satisfaction from being involved in umpiring.

The year was not as demanding as previous years due to the reduced number of reports required to attend the tribunal.

The tribunal sat on 46 cases which were down by 36 on season 2008.

Of these 46 cases 79% returned a guilty verdict.

It was very pleasing to have had fewer cases attend the tribunal relating directly to umpires last year we heard 35 cases compared to 13 cases in season 2009.

The clubs and officials are to be congratulated on this result, although 13 is still 13 too many.

The tribunal next season will adopt the same no tolerance approach applicable to any player/

official found guilty on charges relating to umpires, with penalties being applied to all such guilty outcomes.

Another pleasing part of the season was the reduction in the number of reports applicable to player/player incidents down from 40 to 33 which once again showed that the clubs have focused on, on field discipline.

The result applicable to on field discipline and the efforts the clubs have put into this area speaks for itself with the number of reports including automatics coming down from 162 (2007), 137 (2008) to 98 in season 2009.

This is the 3rd season of delegate accreditation; the quality of representation at the tribunal has improved considerably...

I would like to thank the clubs and umpire association for the way the players, officials and umpires presented themselves at the Tribunal during the year.

A special thanks to Brian Wilson who once again held the front desk together throughout the entire season.

The aim of the tribunal in season 2010 is to not have to turn up on Tuesday night to here any case, last year we experienced this on a few occasions next year we expect this to increase.

# Treasurers Report

It is with satisfaction that I report a financial profit for the third year running for the WRFL. Our year end performance generated an operating surplus of \$50,532. Half of this is redistributed back to our football clubs giving a final surplus of \$25,272.

One area of focus for the 2009 season has been improvement in return from our Properties division. I am pleased to report that by focusing on our product range and the individual cost of specific

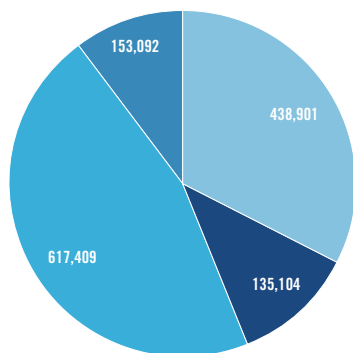
items, we have been able to increase the properties contribution by 16.1% or over \$11,000. This is despite a reduction in properties sales, indicating that further commitment by clubs to purchasing under this WRFL umbrella arrangement will continue to drive a greater return for the League in future.

Our Balance Sheet continues to consolidate in line with this result and we are in the enviable position of having total equity in excess of \$570,000. This financial strength is important as the WRFL looks to review all options available for location of our

administrative base, a decision that will be made in 2010.

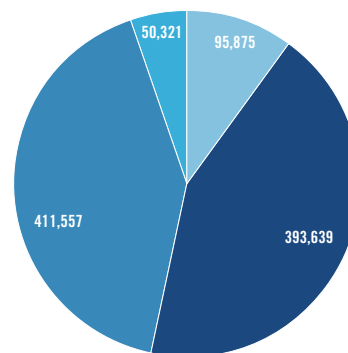

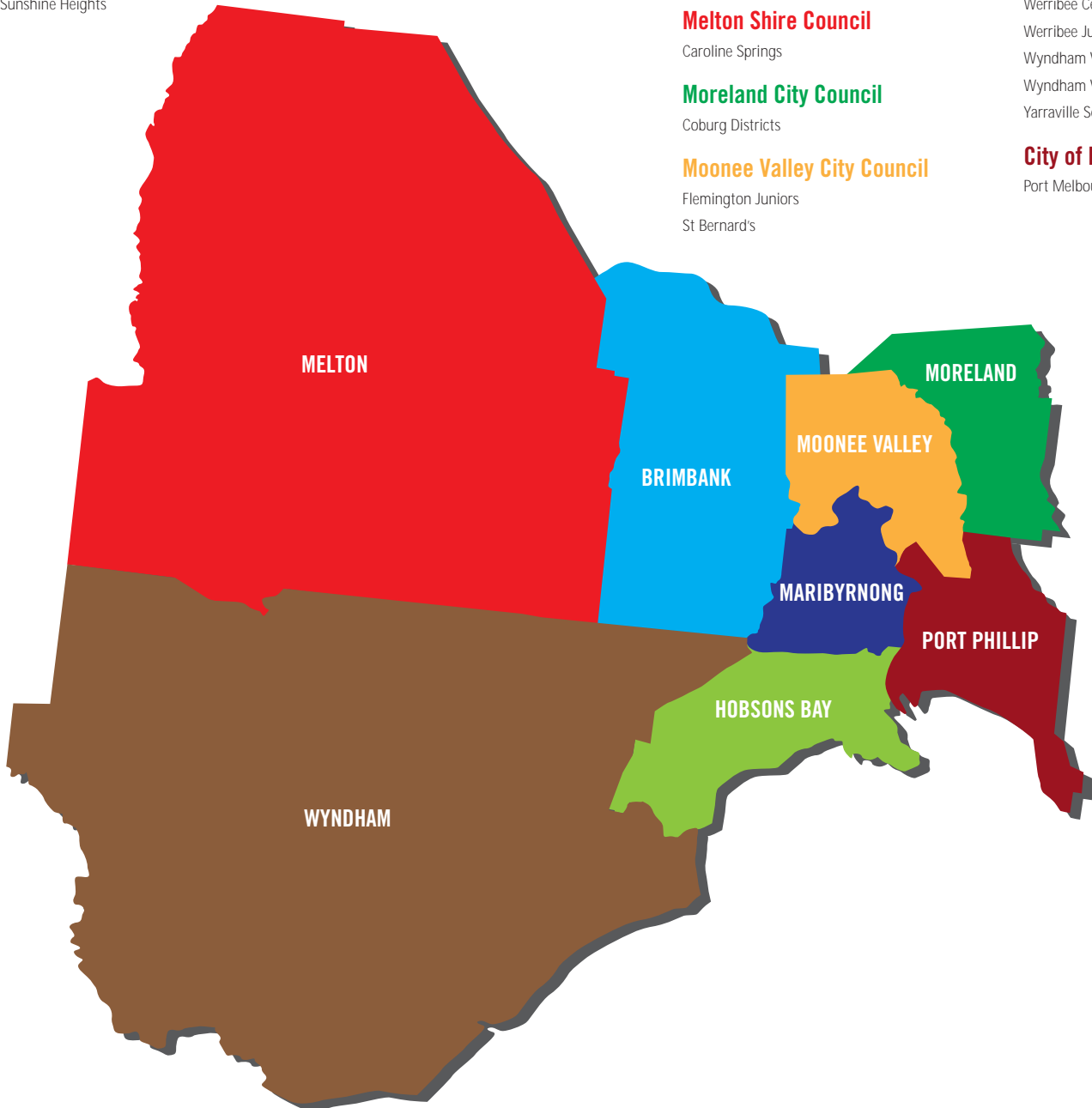
